Addendum:

Jean MAMER ¹ was born in Septfontaines in 1807 as son of Georges MAMER, journalier.

In 1824 father MAMER, however, took over the local mill by the name of "Follmühle" ², which he converted from a *Lohmühle* to an *Oelmühle*. He was presumably joined there by his son Jean, as suggested by the first available census of 1843 which shows that Jean MAMER was married to Susanne HOFFMANN from nearby Kehlen, that the couple had settled at the mill and that son Jean and father Georges were earning their living as "*huiliers*, *Oelmacher*".
