

# ANGELSBURG Pierre

(1840 - 1917) <sup>1</sup>

Perl 

## Biography

Pierre ANGELSBURG was the son of Wilhelm ANGELSBURG (*Ackersmann*), born in Grosbous, and Catharina WEYLAND, born in Perl .

Pierre was born in Perl  in 1840.

In 1872 he married Elisabeth FRISING, born in 1847 in Ettelbruck. Pierre's occupation was *Steinh ndler* and Elisabeth was *Dienstmagd* in Reims (FR) at the time. The couple had eight children.

ANGELSBURG was an *Ackerer*, *Schenkwrith*, *Handelsmann* in Perl .

In the late 1890s he was *conseiller communal* in Perl .

The ANGELSBURG-FRISING couple owned *ardoisi res* (slate quarries) in Perl : <sup>2</sup>

*Les propri taires d'ardoisi res « Angelsberg-Frising »   Perl  (Grand-Duch  de Luxembourg) occupent 80, 90, 100 ouvriers, suivant la saison.*

They also owned the Hotel Ancre d'Or on the Place Guillaume in Luxembourg-city. They sold it in 1914. (see Addendum)

Pierre ANGELSBURG died in 1917 in Luxembourg-city (22 Marie-Theresien Gasse).
