



## **AREND Felix**

(1902 - 1970) <sup>1</sup> Capellen

## **Biography**

Auguste Félix AREND was born in Capellen (Mamer) in 1902. His father Paul Félix AREND (1870-1952) was a medical doctor in Capellen until 1929 when he moved to Luxembourg-city.

His mother Anna Maria PRAUM (1874-1936) was the daughter of Auguste PRAUM (1831-1885) a merchant in rue Beaumont in the centre of Luxembourg-city.

Félix AREND (junior) started off studying law but qualified in 1926 as *licencié en sciences commerciales* at the *Ecole des Hautes Etudes Commerciales* in Paris.

He set up as consultant under the title of ingénieur-conseil. He also actuated as administrateur de sociétés.

In 1935 he set up an office in the boulevard du Viaduc as ingénieur, conseil en propriété industrielle. <sup>2</sup>

AREND took part in the creation of a number of patent holdings in Luxembourg, for which a legal framework had been established in 1922.

His hobby was aeronautics (founding member of the Aéro-Club du Gr.-D. de Luxembourg) and he was a leading member of the Union européenne des fédéralistes.

AREND married Henriette ACHTEN in 1970, at he age of 68, two weeks before he died.
