## Addendum

### The CAMPILLs in Luxembourg

The CAMPILLs originate from Echternach where the family can be traced back to the 17th century.

An individual with the name of Edmund Gustav CAMPILL (1897 - 1969), other than the one retained, could possibly be considered as the inventor of interest. <sup>1</sup>

He was born in Dommeldange (Eich) and was the son of August Gustave CAMPILL. <sup>2</sup>

Father, August Gustav CAMPILL (1861-1939), was a *Kaufmann/Fuhrmann* selling *Baumaterialien und Kohlen* in an establishment close to the train station of Dommeldange. He also had set up a *Cement Waarenfabrik* in Dommeldange. <sup>3</sup> He had died before the filing date of the patents of interest.

Son, Edmund Gustav CAMPILL (1897 - 1969), became a *mître-mécanicien* and ran an *atelier mécanique de précision* in Dommeldange (37-39, route de Beggen), up to the end of his life.

It would appear, though, that the title of *directeur d'usine* does not fit his professional profile.
